ASTTBC Calls for One Professional Association to Regulate House Inspectors

ASTTBC has issued a call for changes to the Regulation governing House Inspectors, indicating that having four separate groups means four separate standards, which does not serve the public interest. ASTTBC has been in touch with Consumer Protection BC and the BC Government asking for changes.

Executive Director John Leech applauded government's 2009 licensing regulation of House Inspectors as a step forward. However, he is now concerned that the consumer may be at greater risk, unless professional certification is changed to be offered in BC by one body and not four independent organizations.
