

Frank D'Angio, AScT Receives Professional Achievement Award at Powell River Council

The ASTTBC **Professional Achievement Award** honours members who have distinguished themselves in their field of technology, and have made a substantial contribution to the well-being of the community.

Richard Stogre, AScT, now retired from the position of Manager of Engineering Services with Powell River, sent in a nomination for Frank D'Angio, AScT. In his nomination Richard said, "Having grown up in this community, Frank D'Angio's commitment to Powell River shines through in all his work. He is indispensable. He deserves recognition for the many years of excellence in serving the City of Powell River, and for the highlight of his career - the magnificent revitalization of our waterfront."

Richard lauded Frank's "career highlight" work as the **project leader** for the \$6 million South Harbour Expansion Project, the North Harbour Reconfiguration Project with a budget of \$7.5 Million, and the Wharf at Westview Project with a budget of \$3.2 Million. These projects ran concurrently beginning in 2010, reaching completion in late 2011. Stogre wrote, "Frank worked tirelessly and achieved results to

be proud of. The waterfront has become a beautiful gateway to our city, benefiting the entire community.”

Frank D’Angio received a 25-year Service Pin from the City of Powell River last December. His fellow Applied Science Technologists and Technicians are well aware that his knowledge and experience have made him a huge asset to the engineering department and the city. He has pursued professional development throughout his career. City officials tell us he’s been an innovator - especially when it comes to saving taxpayer dollars on projects by doing things in-house.
