MLA Ralph Sultan, PEng, an Honourary Member of ASTTBC, and ASTTBC CEO John Leech, enjoyed lunch together earlier this month. The conversation included a number of topics of interest to ASTTBC including the Association's role as a professional regulatory body, ASTTBC linkages with MLAs, the contribution of ASTTBC members to the BC economy, practice rights for ASTTBC members, and promotion of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM).

The two also talked briefly about the role of the Public Representatives on ASTTBC Council and their Annual Report for 2014. Ralph and John rounded out their 90 minute conversation reflecting on joint and several liability (an issue connected to a change in the limitation period for liability enacted by Government during his mandate) and ASTTBC's connections with other professional associations, notably APEGBC.
