**Howard Hedley, AScT - ASTTBC Member #0008**  
**and Past President Passes at 88**

ASTTBC has just learned of the passing of one of our founding members, Howard Hedley, AScT. President in 1962 - 1963, Howard helped frame the Association when a group of technologists and technicians gathered in the mid-50s to consider forming an association for architectural and engineering technologists and technicians. Registered as member #008, Howard was one of the very first to get registered with what was, on formation in 1958, known as the Society of Architectural and Engineering Technologists.

"Howard continued to provide leadership in many aspects of the association over decades" said ASTTBC CEO John Leech on learning of his passing. "I had the very good fortune of working with Howard as he continued to volunteer with ASTTBC. Howard enjoyed a long career with BC Telephone (now TELUS), notably as lead of the company's training program, a significant portion of which was focused on securing and sustaining TELUS' technical skills."
