ASTTBC has partnered with Back in Motion (BIM) to offer members the Canada-BC Job Grant (CJG). This is an employer-driven, cost-sharing program that is designed to help employers offset the expense of employee training. The grant covers up to two-thirds of the cost of training an employee, to a maximum government contribution of \$10,000 for each employee trained.

Back in Motion (a government approved Delivery Partner) offers free individualized support to employers throughout the process, from providing information on the CJG through to the final application submission. We can even help assess training needs, develop training plans and organize group training. Who can apply?

The CJG is currently accepting applications from BC employers who plan to train new or existing employees. Funds have been allocated for BC Jobs Plan [PRIORITY SECTOR](#) employers, and any employers planning to train New Canadians and/or Refugees.

Training must commence on or before March 31st, 2016 to be eligible, so don't delay!
