The Executives of CEBC and ASTTBC met in December to review several topics of interest to both groups. CEBC is an industry association representing consulting engineering firms. With many ASTTBC members and other technologists and technicians as employees, ASTTBC has a natural interest in linking with CEBC. The topics ranged from ASTTBC's sponsorship of the CEBC Awards and ASTTBC representation on the CEBC Awards judging panel to CEBC programs like the Young Professional Group (YPG). The joint executives took note of submissions by both CEBC and ASTTBC on Government's review of the Limitation Act. ASTTBC updated CEBC folk on the steps being taken by ASTTBC and APEGBC to form two task forces dealing with (1) the Limited License; and (2) PTech.
