ASTTBC Submits Article to Electrical Line Magazine

ASTTBC has been working with the British Columbia Safety Authority (BCSA) for some time to develop a model that would legitimize the specialized electrical work that many of our members in the electrical, electronic and bio-medical disciplines perform.

Electrical Work in British Columbia is restricted to a TQ'd Electrician, a Manufacturer's Representative recognized by BCSA or those working through regulatory supervision under an electrical permit. This new certification initiative WILL NOT allow members to work as installation electricians but it WILL now enable them to continue to legally perform in limited fields of special work; such as advanced testing, servicing and repairing of electrical/electronic and bio-medical equipment.
