- \* *Defined requirements for CPD and CPD auditing is coming for ASTTBC registrants*
- \* *ASTTBC has reached an agreement with BC Construction Safety Alliance on the CSO program,*
- \* *ASTTBC will launch the Electrical Work Practitioner program in early March, an initiative authorizes by the BC Safety Authority*
