MLA Michelle Mungall (Nelson-Creston) Talks with ASTTBC

Official Opposition Critic for Advanced Education, Michelle Mungall met last week in Victoria with Executive Director, John Leech, to talk about ASTTBC's new Report, 'A Strategic Direction for Technology Education & Skills in BC'.

The two reviewed key elements of the Report, including targeted technology programming in northern and central BC. Leech pitched technology programming at Okanagan and Selkirk Colleges and the College of New Caledonia.

John Leech updated Michelle on the agreement signed between ASTTBC, BCIT and the Vancouver Board of Education to introduce technology programming in K-12 leading to special enrolment consideration at BCIT. An ASTTBC certificate is planned for high school students who complete the program.

ASTTBC is meeting with MLAs and other community and industry leaders as opportunity arises to talk about the Report's recommendations throughout BC.
