ASTTBC and APEGBC Issue Joint Reports re: PTech & EngL

ASTTBC and APEGBC Councils formed two joint task forces in December 2010, one to consider the implementation of the Professional Technologist (PTech) in BC, taking into account the Alberta model where PTech is now law, and the second to advise on an improved and more effective system for regulating limited licenses to practice professional engineering and professional geoscience.

The ASTTBC and APEGBC Councils have now reviewed the Reports and are working to implement the recommendations of the two Task Forces. The Task Force Reports plus information releases are now available:
