DUTIES:

Acts as a courier as required and performs simple clerical and computational work.

May operate the reproduction machines and performs minor tasks in the Drafting Office.

Performs other work of equal difficulty and responsibility, requiring comparable qualifications.

REQUIREMENTS:

Completion of Grade 12, including or supplemented by courses in mathematics with Trigonometry and Physics.

Completion of one year post-secondary drafting course is desirable.
