A thorough knowledge and understanding of relevant provincial legislation and municipal bylaws relating to municipal engineering and construction principles, practices and procedures are essential.

Preferred candidates will have sound knowledge of the fundamentals of budgeting and standard costing procedures related to engineering and asset management programs and operations.

The successful candidate will have a Diploma in Civil or Structural Technology or an equivalent combination of training and experience. The successful applicant will be registered with the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians Association of BC (ASTTBC) or be eligible for membership. You must possess a valid Class 5 BC driver's license.
