The Engineering Parks & Environment Department requires a regular, full-time Design Technician.

As a Design Technician, you will design municipal services and systems such as storm and sanitary sewers, water mains, roads and sidewalks to conform to sound engineering and economic principles. Your main duties will include preparing drawings, designs and cost estimates for engineering services and systems, conducting field inspections of assigned projects and making recommendations for changes as required. You will also prepare technical information and assistance to a variety of internal and external contacts.

You will have completed a minimum of two (2) years of a Civil Engineering program, leading to a certificate in Civil Engineering. Skills and experience with AutoCAD and MS Office Suite as well as a valid Class 5 BC Driver's License are required. Registration as a Certified Technician with the ASTTBC is also a requirement. Experience with ArcGIS, and hydraulic modeling software (eg. PCSWMM, InfoWater, etc.) would be advantageous.
