Additionally, you will be providing assistance with all permit applications with a major focus on soil permitting.

We are seeking an experienced technologist who has the ability to:

- read and interpret mapping plans, designs and specifications related to civil engineering;
- pay close attention to detail and be precise and accurate;
- communicate ideas and solutions clearly and concisely orally and in writing; and
- write accurate and grammatically correct technical reports for a non-technical audience.

Along with an aptitude for problem solving and innovation, you should enjoy taking a methodical approach to your work, analyzing data, finding innovative solutions to problems and working with computerized mapping, drafting, design software and related computer applications.

The ideal candidate will have a diploma in Civil Engineering Technology, or recognized academic equivalent, and a minimum of three years of experience in a municipal engineering or development planning environment. Considerable knowledge in municipal engineering design principles, methods and techniques and applied mathematics along with knowledge and understanding of provincial legislation, municipal bylaws and policies relating to land use are necessary for success in this role.
