This position is intended to provide project management and technical support to all components of the program.

The Engineering Project Coordinator provides civil and structural technical engineering and project management services for the University Endowment Lands. Projects may include major repairs, installation or upgrades to: underground services (water, sanitary, storm), surface works (roads, curbs, sidewalks, trails, street lighting, rain gardens) and boulevards, parks and facilities.
