As a member of the Development Services team, the successful incumbent will review and process the engineering servicing and related legal and financial aspects of development and building permit applications to ensure compliance with municipal engineering standards and requirements. This position will work closely with developers/consultants and other City staff in the processing of these applications and other project tasks, as appropriate.

More specifically, the position will:

- compile, review and complete engineering servicing requirements for subdivision, development permit, rezoning, OCP amendment and other related project tasks to ensure compliance with applicable by-laws and requirements of the City pertinent to land development activities;
- exercise and provide specialized and technical advice and direction; interpret and explain City policies, procedures, regulations, by-laws and other requirements to developers/consultants, other City staff and the general public;
- work with various Engineering asset managers to analyze existing water, storm and sanitary sewer systems to determine capacities and evaluate alternative servicing options and impact on existing Municipal services; and
- review correspondence and reports, and draft agreements specifying facts, findings, conclusions and/or recommendations, where appropriate.

The Ideal candidate in this position will be a graduate of a post-secondary program with a diploma in Civil or Structural Engineering plus sound related experience, preferably in a municipal environment, or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Certification or eligibility for certification as an Applied Science Technologist within the Province of British Columbia or an equivalent combination of training and experience is desirable. A valid BC Driver's license is required.
