Electrical, Mechanical, Drainage/Irrigation Superintendent

Reporting to the Assistant Operations Manager, the Electrical, Mechanical, and Drainage/Irrigation Superintendent is accountable for the supervisory, technical and administrative work involved in the effective operations of a utility branch of the Engineering Operations Division in the Engineering Department. The incumbent is responsible for the planning, assigning, inspecting and supervising, directly and through staff, the work of crews engaged in maintenance, installation, trouble shooting and repair tasks for street lighting, traffic signals, sanitary and drainage pump stations, SCADA controls, radio system and agricultural watercourses. The Superintendent is required to act independently and use appropriate judgement in processing assignments, and may act on behalf of the City in civil matters such as Examinations for Discovery and other court cases.

Education and Experience

Minimum grade 12 education supplemented by technical and management courses. A minimum 10 years of experience in public works with some supervisory experience is required. A professional designation in electrical or mechanical technology is an asset for this position.

Skills and Knowledge

In addition to being able to demonstrate effective leadership skills in a team environment and a commitment to excellence in their day-to-day work, candidates must also demonstrate job knowledge through familiarity and understanding of job requirements, received through education and training, as well as practical experience. Strong communication skills, both oral and written, and the ability to function well under all types of pressures are key attributes that successful candidates will already possess. Ability to plan ahead in order to anticipate problems and meet changing needs, and the ability to generate new ideas and develop alternate solutions to problems, as well as the ability to work without close supervision, on effectiveness at organizing time, level of effort on work assignments, and the ability to meet agreed-upon timelines are all attributes that the successful incumbent will possess.

This position requires a valid BC class 5 driver's licence.
