We are seeking a highly motivated Environmental Sciences professional to work with us as an Environmental Technologist. Based in Nelson, this position works as part of the Resource Recovery team to support the general operations and ongoing compliance requirements of all solid waste management services throughout the RDCK. This includes landfills, transfer stations, recycling programs and facilities, composting facilities and more. This is a technical role and will suit applicants with considerable knowledge of best practices and operations of solid waste management systems and programs. The Environmental Technologist will work closely with colleagues, contractors, consultants and the public to ensure activities are carried out in accordance to the appropriate policies, standard and regulations. Preference will be given to candidates with solid waste management experience.

This is a benefitted, full-time opportunity, commencing as soon as possible and continuing until December 31, 2019.
