Reporting to the Director of Strategic Projects, the Project Manager is expected to provide recommendations and direction with a calculated lens from concept to construction in a complex, multi-functional and political environment. This position will require a proven track record for building relationships with and across functional teams as well as with key internal/external stakeholders, and the ability to effectively resolve issues and identify opportunities with managed exposure/risk to the City.

The successful incumbent will be politically astute and bring a minimum 7 to 10 years of experience in managing a portfolio of projects in a range of related industry sectors, a University Degree in Engineering, Technology, Architecture or Construction Management or an equivalent combination of academic and practical experience in a related discipline. Experience in a municipal setting is desirable.

Professional industry credentials such as P.Eng., PMP, RA, ASCT or other similar industry recognized designation is considered a strong asset.
