The successful candidate will have graduated with either a diploma or certificate in Civil Engineering Technology from an accredited post-secondary technical program and have a minimum of two years' related field experience. You must be registered, or be eligible for registration, as an AScT or CTech by the Applied Science Technologist & Technicians of British Columbia. A strong customer service orientation along with excellent interpersonal skills and superior written and oral communication abilities will assist you in this advisory role. A valid, unrestricted Class 5 BC driver's license (or out of province equivalent) is also required.
