

## TECHNOLOGIST AND TECHNICIAN CASE SUMMARIES 2019

### **CASE #19-01**

#### **STATEMENT OF COMPLAINT:**

That the Respondent (An ASTTBC registrant in the Associate member category): 1) Failed to hold paramount the safety, health and welfare of the public and the protection of the environment, and 2) Expressed professional opinions for which the Respondent either lacked knowledge or with the intention of misrepresenting the facts.

#### **INVESTIGATION:**

The Respondent's involvement in the matter began 14 years ago (circa 2004) when they examined a stream on a property in response to erosion concerns raised by the previous owners. The complaint alleged that the Respondent dismissed the previous owner's concerns with an explanation that misrepresented the facts and denied responsibility for the erosion damage.

#### **PRACTICE REVIEW BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The PRB reviewed the complaint and resolved that as the complaint had been received outside the 2-year limitation period as stipulated in the ASTT Regulations, the PRB considered the complaint to be extinguished.

#### **OUTCOME:**

The file was closed.
