1. SUBJECT: Registrar Report for January 2022 Council Meeting

2. PURPOSE:

To provide Council with a summary of ASTTBC's regulatory activities for the period of March 10 – April 20, 2022.

3. DISCUSSION:

As reported at the previous meeting work remains to be done at the detailed level of policies, guidelines, and procedures as ASTTBC continues to meet its regulatory mandate. We are excited to have a new employee who will work across multiple departments updated policies and procedures.

Statutory Committees

Since our last meeting the Audit and Practice Review Committee has met and reviewed the CPD audit results. The Credentials Committee and file reviewers have experienced a significant increase in number and complexity of registration applications. The Investigations Committee has also met to review a number of complaints.

Annual Elections

A notice was sent out to all eligible registrants that voting for the new registrant Councillors began on April 5 and will continue until April 22.

AGM

A notice on April 5 was sent to all registrants regarding the agenda for the Annual General Meeting, taking place on May 6, 2022 in person in Penticton, as well as online.

Human Resources

As noted during the previous open meeting of the ASTTBC Council, the former Registrar bid her farewell. Council has appointed Theresa McCurry as the Registrar and Michael Thain as the Deputy Registrar. Both positions are interim, at this point in time.
