Under the direction of the Manager of Transportation and Drainage, the incumbent will be working as part of a team responsible for the management, planning and construction of municipal infrastructure.

Reporting to the Manager of Transportation and Drainage you will be responsible to plan, budget and deliver capital improvement projects, relating to roads, bridges, drainage and dyking infrastructure.

You will be required to supervise the work of contractors, and consultants, and periodically department employees, carry out technical investigations relating to road construction, transportation operation, drainage works and dyke infrastructure.

Required knowledge, skills and abilities:

- A graduate of an Institute of Technology in a minimum two (2) year Civil engineering program.
- Ten years' experience working with roads and traffic issues or equivalent combination of education and experience and eligible for certification in the ASTTBC.
- Experience in local government.
- Required knowledge of transportation and drainage design principles, the ability to plan long range road, transportation, drainage and dyking improvements.
- Experience in public promotion, and managing projects, conducting research and feasibility studies is required.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, you need the ability to express thoughts and ideas clearly, and converse with a wide range of people including; technical consultants, elected officials, senior staff, and the general public.
- Excellent writing skills, with the ability to write in a clear and concise manner, and to prepare well written technical and administrative reports.
