We have an exciting and rewarding opportunity for a Temporary Full-time Transportation Planning Technologist to join our team. As a member of our Engineering and Public Works Transportation team, you will support the development of our Strategic Transportation Plan; review and prepare Transportation Demand Management strategies and plans; provide assistance to the E-Mobility program. In addition, the incumbent will prepare and coordinate surveys and analyze results; conduct various transportation engineering analysis and research on municipal transportation issues and matters pertaining to new and on-going transportation project; oversee the work of consultants engaged in technical and research projects; prepare reports outlining findings, options and proposals; and organize and attend public consultation events.

Along with a team-player attitude and relevant experience in transportation planning, you have a diploma in an appropriate discipline such as civil engineering technology or urban planning from a recognized institute of technology, preferable certification or eligibility for certification as an Applied Science Technologist (AScT) from the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians of BC. Strong computer abilities, attention to detail and accuracy, as well as excellent interpersonal and communication skills are required. A valid BC driver's license is required.

The rate of pay for this CUPE position is \$40.29 - \$47.57 per hour (2022 rates), plus 6 % in lieu of benefits, and an earned day off program are being offered. This position is based in Coquitlam with some flexible, remote work options available. Applicants under consideration will be required to undergo a police security clearance evaluation and provide a recent Driver's Abstract (with no adverse reports).
