Building construction is consistently the top contributor to the Provincial GDP among goods-producing industries, outranking mining, oil and gas extraction, forestry, agriculture, and manufacturing industries.

The Building and Safety Standards Branch has responsibility for establishing and maintaining technical regulations for buildings and technical systems; fostering partnerships and other key relationships; supporting our regulatory framework via non-regulatory activities, including delegating to our core partners (including statutory and others); and providing advice and input pertaining to the regulatory systems for buildings and technical systems – to partners, industry and other levels of government.

The Senior Codes Administrator provides technical research and/or technical analysis/evaluation related to the governance framework of building regulatory and safety systems, and the technical requirements of the B.C. Building, Plumbing, Fire, and Safety Codes and regulations, and supports industry, local governments, and other stakeholders in understanding and using the codes. The responsibilities of this position may involve all aspects of leading significant projects, including project management, stakeholder consultation, developing and delivering training, and research and analysis. This position will involve a high degree of interaction with stakeholders and the public, including delivering presentations, participating in committees, and providing direct support to code users.

**Qualifications for this role include:**

- Undergraduate degree, technical diploma or trade certification/Red Seal Endorsement in a related field or a Certified Building Official with recognized British Columbia designation (e.g. RBO, BCQ or CRBO) and five (5) years related experience.
- An equivalent combination of related education and experience may be considered.
- Experience in planning, developing, implementing, analyzing and evaluating technical proposals.
- Experience in developing technical regulations and policies.
- Experience leading diverse multi-stakeholder groups in the development of policy, technical requirements, discussion papers, etc.
- Research experience.
