ENGINEERING PROJECT TECHNOLOGIST - TRANSPORTATION

The City of Delta is looking for a qualified Engineering Project Technologist for the Transportation Division of the Engineering Department. This is technical engineering position to develop solutions to key transportation issues within the City of Delta. The incumbent will work closely with a small team of professional engineers and engineering technologists to provide the overall capital planning for the City's transportation related infrastructure.

The work involves planning and implementation of road safety strategies, active transportation initiatives and neighbourhood road improvement projects. In addition, the work involves estimating project construction costs; preparing specifications and contract documents; consulting and maintaining liaison with and providing information, assistance and direction to a wide variety of internal and external contacts. Work priorities are established by the department, however within those parameters the incumbent will exercise considerable independence of judgement and action in the technical aspects of the work discussing difficult technical problems, policy and budgetary matters with the transportation team.

The ideal candidate for this job will have the following:

- Minimum three (3) years of experience in Transportation engineering, preferably in municipal government;
- Sound knowledge of the planning, design, construction and implementation of roads, traffic calming, active transportation, traffic signals, street lighting, and bus stop infrastructure;
- Experience in planning, conducting and preparing request for proposals for transportation projects and studies
- Experience in AutoCAD, pavement management practices and transportation modelling software;
- Experience in writing technical reports and memos
- Strong engineering analytical and interpersonal skills;

Applicants must be registered or eligible for registration with the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians of BC (ASTTBC) as an Applied Science Technologist (AScT) or Technician (CTech), or as an Engineer-in-Training (E.I.T) with the Engineers and Geoscientists BC (EGBC). A valid Class 5 BC Drivers' License is required.

The City of Delta provides a competitive salary \$43.82 - \$51.78 per hour (commensurate with experience); and an excellent benefits package including Municipal Pension Plan as well as a 9-day fortnight system.
