Knowledge of Synchro and Simtraffic microsimulation software and Centraqs/Econolite system software is considered an asset.

You possess a Civil Engineering Degree and a P.Eng. with a minimum of 5 years related experience in traffic or transportation engineering. You may also have several years' experience with traffic signal and active transportation projects, and management of capital projects, preferably within a municipal environment.
