SENIOR ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGIST - DEVELOPMENT

The City of Delta is seeking a full-time Senior Engineering Technologist for the Development Department. This is technical engineering work in the municipal infrastructure field; the incumbent will work with minimal supervision to train, mentor, plan, assign, and check the work of the Engineering Technologist team, reporting to the Manager of Development Engineering. An incumbent will assign development projects to one or more Engineering Technologists, oversees day-to-day section operations, and carries out development project work. Considerable independent judgement is required in the technical and administrative aspects of the work, while the more complex and unusual technical problems, policy and financial matters include the Manager.

Some day to day responsibilities are:

- Coordinate the activities of the Land Development function with interdepartmental activities, such as bylaws, communications, permits and inspections, major development applications through the Planning Departments, Engineering and Parks, Recreation & Culture;
- Coordinate with other civic departments to obtain required input and approvals prior to acceptance;
- Oversees planning and permitting land functions and review associated with major development applications including rezoning and subdivision and complex construction projects;
- Assists manager in developing policies and procedures and recommending changes to regulations and bylaws

The ideal candidate for this job will have the following:

- Minimum five (5) years of experience in land development, municipal infrastructure design & drafting, construction, and inspection (3 years of local experienced preferred);
- Knowledge of common engineering design and construction practices including engineering software (ie Auto CAD);
- Strong engineering analytical skills;
- Strong interpersonal skills;
- Experience with or knowledge of Construction Contract Documents,
- Experience with asset management systems, and Tempest software preferred

Required Qualifications:

- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence.
- Registered **OR** eligible for registration with the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians of BC (ASTTBC) as an Applied Science Technologist (AScT) or Technician (CTech) or equivalent
