The Engineering Services department has an opportunity for qualified individuals to apply for the position of Engineering Technologist. Reporting to the Manager of Engineering Services, this position offers 72 hours bi-weekly starting as soon as possible.

The Engineering Technologist is responsible for plan checking; conveying procedures and specifications to contractors and development applicants; inspecting and supervising the installation of public works; and review of legal documents.

Qualified candidates have completed a Civil Engineering Technology Diploma and possess certification as an Applied Science Technician or Technologist with the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians of British Columbia and at least 1-3 years of experience in a similar role including inspecting and/or supervising the installation and/or rehabilitation of buried municipal utilities. Qualified candidates demonstrate good working knowledge of the methods, materials, tools and equipment used in construction maintenance and repair of municipal water, sewer and drainage works and of municipal engineering practices. Qualified candidates are proficient with a variety of Microsoft software applications and databases, AutoCAD, and ArcGIS with the ability to learn new and changing technology and can effectively read, interpret and create technical plans.

The successful candidate is a professional individual and demonstrates excellent verbal and written communication skills and is analytical and research-oriented with the ability to effectively respond to inquiries from builders, homeowners and the public regarding specifications, service information, legal lot surveys, record drawing information and can work well under pressure, manage competing demands and effectively prioritize workload. The successful candidate demonstrates commitment to promoting a diverse and inclusive workplace within their team and will create and maintain effective working relationships with others while contributing to a positive teamwork environment. As a requirement of the position, the successful applicant must hold a valid BC class 5 driver's license and must provide a satisfactory driver's abstract and a satisfactory Police Information Check prior to beginning employment
