Situated within the shared, unceded territory of the Lílwat7úl (Lílwat People) and Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish People), the Resort Municipality of Whistler (RMOW) is a vibrant destination resort community, local government organization and leader in providing municipal programs, services, progressive planning and infrastructure. The RMOW is a high performance municipal organization and significant tourism economy serving a community of 14,000 permanent residents and over three million annual visitors. Whistler's vision is to be a place where our community thrives, nature is protected and guests are inspired.

The Utilities Group department has an opportunity for qualified individuals to apply for the position of Engineering Technologist - Utilities Maintenance Planner. Reporting to the Utilities Group Manager, this position offers 72 hours bi-weekly starting as soon as possible.

Primary responsibilities include fulfilling requirements related to planning and scheduling maintenance requirements for multiple operations and trade groups to maintain the highest equipment readiness standards for water resource management. Specifically involving RMOW water supply, treatment, and distribution; wastewater collection and treatment; and landfill post closure care and District Energy systems (DES). The role is the primary Utilities Group resource and liaison for the municipal work order and asset management system and, in cooperation with maintenance and operations supervisory staff, will prioritize and coordinate the scheduling of all preventive maintenance and planned corrective maintenance work to ensure consistent quality and continuity of system operation.

Qualified candidates have completed post-secondary education in a directly related field, or an equivalent combination of training and work-related experience including Interprovincial Trade qualification, supplemented by maintenance management and planning courses with certification (or eligibility for registration) as an ASCT with the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians BC and, at least 1-3 years of experience in a similar role including asset and work order management. Qualified candidates demonstrate strong working knowledge of asset management concepts and systems preferably within a local government environment; good working knowledge of municipal water, wastewater and treatment works and municipal engineering operations and practices; and strong skills in Geographic Information Systems (GIS), database, and data analysis. Knowledge of CityWorks, SharePoint, FlowWorks, WaterTrax and Tempest is an asset.

The successful candidate is professional and approachable with great communications skill and a well-developed safety awareness with the ability to effectively lead in the development and implementation of (new or improve existing) asset and work order management systems, methods, techniques, procedures, and best practices based on current industry standards. The successful candidate also demonstrates commitment to promoting a diverse and equitable workplace within their team and will create and maintain effective working relationships with others while contributing to a positive team environment. As a requirement of the position, the successful applicant must hold a valid BC class 5 driver's license and must provide a satisfactory driver's abstract prior to beginning employment.
