Located on Vancouver Island, the CVRD provides a wide range of local government services to a population of 80,000 within its 4 distinct municipalities and 9 electoral areas. Just 50 km north of Victoria and 30 km south of Nanaimo, the Cowichan Valley offers a warm climate and numerous parks, recreational, cultural, and social opportunities.

The Cowichan Valley Regional District is now accepting applications for the regular full time Engineering Technologist I position in the Utilities Division within the Operations Department.

General Information

Reporting to the Manager - Utilities, the Engineering Technologist I is responsible for performing a wide variety of technical tasks of a municipal engineering nature related to sewer, water, and drainage; including processing applications, taking inquiries from customers, operational monitoring, data collection and input, and assisting with developing hydraulic computer models for water and wastewater systems. The Engineering Technologist I is also responsible for assisting in maintaining and updating the asset inventories.

Qualifications

- Graduation from a recognized post-secondary institution with a diploma in civil engineering and eligible for membership in the ASTT as a technologist/technician, or a combination of education and appropriate training and experience
- Preferably, minimum of one (1) year related job or cooperative work experience in a similar field
- WHMIS Certificate – provided by employer
- Occupational First Aid Level I with CPR C
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's License

Hours of Work: The hours of work are 35 hours per week, Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This position may be required to attend some evening and weekend meetings. Flex time is offered with this position. This position may be eligible for part-time Work-From-Home consideration after completion of the training period.

Salary: This union position (CUPE Local 358) has a salary range in three steps: \$37.53 – \$38.60 - \$39.76 per hour (2023 rates). A comprehensive benefits package including extended health / dental / insurance, pension, and paid vacation is offered with this position as per the CUPE Collective Agreement.
