

Requirements of ID:

1. An applicant must submit two pieces of ID, in which one must be a photo ID.
2. If you are a Canadian, verification of Canadian Citizenship, such as a Canadian passport, Canadian birth certificate, or Canadian citizenship card/certificate is required.
3. Permanent Resident or Work Permit holder must submit their Permanent Resident Card of Work Permit and their valid passport.
4. A scanned copy of ID is accepted.

List of accepted Primary ID:

Issued by ICBC:

- B.C. Driver's Licence or learner's licence (must have your photo)
- B.C. Identification (BCID) card
- B.C. Services Card (must have your photo)

Issued by provincial or territorial government:

- Canadian birth certificate

Issued by Government of Canada (or other country):

- Passport
- Canadian Citizenship Card / Certificate
- Canadian Permanent Resident Card
- Canadian Record of Landing/Canadian Immigration Identification Record
- Nexus Card

Other accepted IDs issued by organizations in Canada:

- School ID card (student card)
- Bank card (only if applicant's name is on card)
- Credit card (only if applicant's name is on card)
- Canadian or U.S. driver's licence
- Naturalization certificate
- Canadian Forces identification
- Police identification
- Foreign Affairs Canada or consular identification
- Vehicle registration (only if applicant's signature is shown)
- Picture employee ID card
- Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL)
- Social Insurance Card (new style without signature strip not acceptable)

- Native Status Card
- Parole Certificate ID
