Electronics Technician

Under the supervision of the Director of Operations or designate, install, program, wire, repair, and maintain electrical equipment and systems.

- Two (2) years Electronic Technology Diploma from an ASTTBC accredited college or university;
- Registered Fire Protection Technician Certificate (RFPT) with ASTTBC;
- Four (4) years' experience as an electronics technician installing, programming, testing and repairing fire and intrusion alarm systems (including addressable fire alarm systems);
- A working understanding of P.A. systems/media retrieval;
- Demonstrated training and work experience in current BC construction/maintenance/safety requirements and WCB Regulation relating to the trade and industry;
- a valid B.C. Drivers License.

Applicants will be expected to:

- possess the physical condition and health to carry out the required duties of this position;
- maintain good interpersonal and communication skills and be self-motivated;
- work alone and within a team environment with minimum supervision;
- have working with Microsoft outlook, word and excel and work order system;
