The Engineering, Parks and Environment Department is looking for a Regular full time Design Technician to join their team.

As a Design Technician, you will design municipal services and systems such as storm and sanitary sewers, water mains, roads and sidewalks to conform to sound engineering and economic principles. Your main duties will include preparing drawings, designs and cost estimates for engineering services and systems, conducting field inspections of assigned projects and making recommendations for changes as required. You will work with internal stakeholders to determine performance requirements for designs and drawings. You will also prepare cost and quantity estimates related to design projects, make technical calculations for a variety of projects, produce drawings including issued for construction drawings and assigned projects, assemble, review, and interpret survey and related utility data related to assigned projects; prepare preliminary drawings and designs for review and approval; and request survey and drafting assistance when appropriate.

You will have completed a minimum of two (2) years of a Civil Engineering program, leading to a certificate in Civil Engineering. Skills and experience with AutoCAD and MS Office Suite as well as a valid Class 5 BC Driver’s License are required. Registration as a Certified Technician with the ASTTBC is also a requirement. Experience with ArcGIS, and hydraulic modeling software (eg. PCSWMM, InfoWater, etc.) would be advantageous.
