- Your outcomes working on 2D drawings include engineering drawings (parts, assemblies, installations) and arrangement drawings (general arrangement, firefighting keyplans, piping diagrammatics, power system diagrams, etc).
- As a Technologist you will play an active role in applying your technical knowledge to research existing vessel documentation, review approved engineering changes to determine system impact and vessel surveys and to confirm accuracy of legacy documentation.
- Your work with Engineering Changes (EC's) will range in specificity based on requirements of our defence clients. General outcomes include/involve modifications to ships, systems and equipment configurations and/or changes to any configuration information.
- Additional outcomes with Engineering Changes include the management of engineering changes as a result of the introduction of new capability or the sustainment of existing capability.
