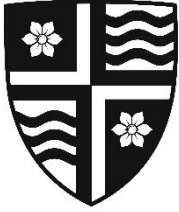

The Township of Langley is currently recruiting for a regular full-time **Engineering Technologist III** to join our team of professionals in the Engineering Division, Stormwater Department. Reporting to the Stormwater Manager, in this unionized position you will apply your knowledge, creativity and experience to coordinate projects, develop work schedules, monitor progress and assist in the direction of design projects and contract administration.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate design, estimating, contract documentation and administration for various construction and installation projects
- Coordinate maintenance programs
- Liaise with a variety of internal/external contacts, consultants, contractors, the public and other agencies on engineering requirements, policies, and related matters
- Perform design and layout work for projects and conduct field inspections
- Plan, assign and supervise the work of other technical staff as required
- Prepare/maintain a variety of documents including reports, contract documents, technical and status reports
- Perform related work as required

Qualifications:

- Graduation from an Institute of Technology with a Civil Engineering Technologist Diploma and considerable related experience, or an equivalent combination of training and experience
- Considerable knowledge of engineering principles and construction practices and procedures applicable to the work performed
- Sound knowledge and experience of budgeting and standard cost fundamentals for projects and programs
- Ability to plan, assign and supervise the work of one or more technical employees
- Working knowledge of the related legislation governing the work performed
- Ability to communicate effectively and tactfully with internal/external contacts, the public, consultants, and contractors
- Working knowledge of the Master Municipal Construction Documents will be considered an asset

- Certification or eligibility for certification as an Applied Science Technologist within the Province of British Columbia

The CUPE rate of pay for this position is \$44.30 - \$52.35 per hour (5 steps, 2023 rates) and \$46.07 - \$54.44 per hour (5 steps, 2024 rates) plus benefits. The hours of work are Monday to Friday 8:00am – 4:30pm.
